Week by week you will learn everything necessary to create a wildlife habitat specific to your property. The course begins with a personalized soil property evaluation and then explores how to attract pollinators like bees, insects, birds and bats. From there you will learn how to understand plant selection and manage invasive species. You will also identify how to attract other wildlife to your backyard, including small mammals like rabbits; a variety of birds; reptiles, such as turtles, and amphibians like frogs and toads.

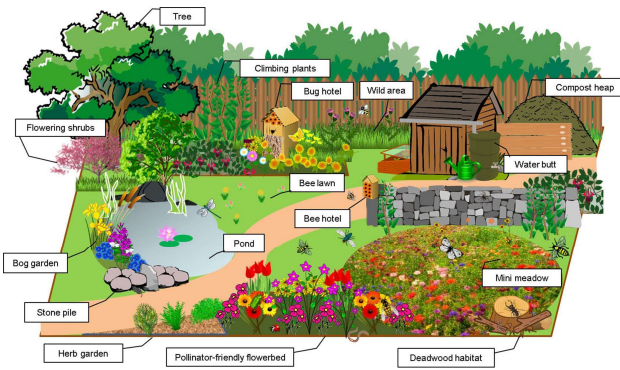

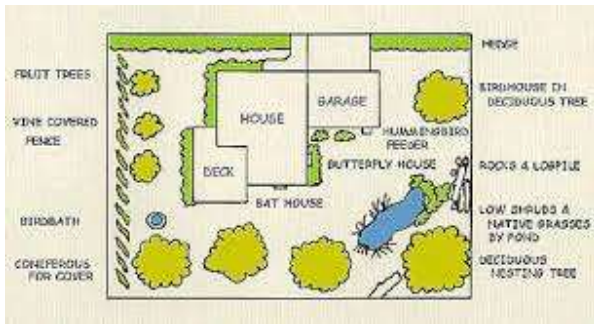

For property owners who would like to learn how to develop a backyard habitat for wildlife. The Oakland Conservation District, is a locally led organization of state government with guidance from USDA. The Oakland Conservation District has a variety of resources to aide local property owners in developing their backyard habitat.

To understand the best backyard habitat, one needs to have knowledge of their property's soil. From this one can then identify the plants that will enable the proper habitat for the wildlife you want in your back yard. Once your plan is approved by the Oakland Conservation District, you will receive a sign promoting your successful certification, which is good for five years.
